Ms. Camp graduated Phi Beta Kappa with a BA in mathematics from Trinity University in San Antonio, Texas, in 1976. She is a Member of the American Academy of Actuaries and a Fellow of the Casualty Actuarial Society. Ms. Camp joined Robert Hughes Associates, Inc., in 1988 as a consulting actuary.

Ms. Camp began her actuarial career in 1976 with the United Services Automobile Association developing data systems and performing rate level reviews for private passenger automobile insurance. As assistant actuary for automobile pricing, her responsibilities included the development of rate level goals and strategies, analysis of state regulation and automobile residual markets.

In 1981, Ms. Camp became a consulting casualty actuary with Independent Actuarial Services of Texas, Inc., where she was named vice president in 1984. Beginning in 1985, Ms. Camp became a vice president and casualty actuarial consultant for Tillinghast, Nelson and Warren, Inc., in Dallas, Texas.
